The outpatients clinic is open:

- Mondays 1 pm – 4pm
- Wednesday 9am – 12 pm

It can be contacted by all immigrants, a regular permit of stay is not necessary for those who need:

1. Examination for contagious diseases
2. Screening tests and treatments for sexually transmitted diseases
3. General practice for those without a tessera sanitaria (healthcare services card)
4. Orientation, provided by AUSL Piacenza

You can access services directly.

Booking or medical prescription is not required.

FURTHER INFORMATION

STP Code:

This document is necessary for emergency treatments, but also for medical examinations, special tests, x-rays etc.

This document is issued specially for immigrants who do not have a valid permit of stay.

To get your STP code, you need a medical certificate, to be shown at the AUSL desks, located in Piazzale Milano.

The STP code expires after 6 months, it may be renewed if in the position of the applicant has not been clarified, yet.

Tessera Sanitaria and the choice of your a family doctor:

Italian citizens and lawful immigrants (i.e. with a valid permit of stay) have the right to get the Tessera Sanitaria (healthcare services card) and to choose their family doctor.

WHAT TO DO?

- Medical certificate (to get your STP code) to be shown at the AUSL desks, in Piazzale Milano.
- Blood tests (only if prescribed by the outpatient clinic doctor).
- General medical examination
- Examination for contagious diseases
- Check-up and specific tests for sexually transmitted diseases
- Medical prescription for special examinations which cannot be not carried out at this patient clinic
- Medical prescription of key medicines
- Life-saving services and treatments should be guaranteed by the family doctor to those patients who already own their Tessera Sanitaria (healthcare services card)

IMPORTANT: For some tests carried out in the outpatient clinic, the payment of a fee (called ticket) may be requested.
